Springfield Introduces Comprehensive Chronic Illness Support Care Model

Skilled Nursing Facility's Patient-Centric Approach Emphasizes Physical and Spiritual Wellness

The facility provides post-hospital care, short-term rehab and long-term residential care.

The overall initiative – which is specifically supporting Springfield’s Pulmonary Care program – also weaves in disease-specific education and health coaching, multi-specialist led and coordinated care, full time respiratory therapy, social services support, and connections to community resources and life enrichment activities.

“Springfield for years has provided exceptional care for those with chronic disease through its physician-lead specialty offerings,” noted Koons. “The facility’s new Chronic Illness Support model introduces an added layer to further improve mental health and wellbeing for these patients and their loved ones.
