Cambridge Appoints Michael Gallagher, DO, as Director of Neuro Recovery

Specialty Initiative at Moorestown, N.J., Skilled Nursing Facility Benefits Subacute and Long-Term Care Populations

MOORESTOWN, N.J. (Jan. 11, 2023) — [Cambridge Rehabilitation & Healthcare Center](#) has appointed Michael Gallagher, DO, as director of its newly introduced Neuro Recovery Program. The specialized initiative focuses on balance, speech, memory and pain management, as well as swallowing and proper nutrition. Patients receive an individualized recovery plan to address their needs, including a return to more routine daily functions, such as sitting, walking, dressing and showering.
